For over ten years Storyteller, Cheryl Thornton has brought her K - 8 drama and storytelling programs to schools throughout Southern Ontario.

**Cheryl Thornton** has designed an interactive storytelling and drama assembly in celebration of Thanksgiving Day. The 60 minute program features engaging myths and folktales of the autumn harvest from Canada's First Nations People as well as insightful multicultural stories about generosity, gratitude and thankfulness.

With the help of props, musical instruments and costume pieces, students assist in bringing the stories to life by dramatizing imaginative tales from long ago and far away.

Students become familiar with stories from diverse cultures throughout the world as they explore their creativity and expand language, cooperative learning and communication skills.

The presentation also includes free access to **Storyvalues**, Cheryl's online storytelling resource, where students are challenged to take *The Storyteller's Journey*, exploring folktales, art and music through videos, games and puzzles.

The digital program is a great way for schools and families to strengthen literacy by learning and sharing stories from around the world.
